PAYMENT

For paper application we only accept cash or cheques. If you would rather apply and pay online, you can do so via our website.

Paying cash/cheque: Cash or cheques need to be returned with the form in a sealed envelope. Cheques must be made payable to 'Northowram School PTFA'.

EVENT RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS

The following event rules and guidelines are intended to ensure the safety of all participants. Northowram Primary School and Northowram Primary School PTFA retain the right to refuse entry to anyone declaring false information on their application, not making the required payment, or otherwise failing to meet the entry requirements. In any and all circumstances Northowram Primary School and Northowram Primary School PTFA retain the right to refuse entry to any person.

PARTICIPATION

All applications must be received on the official application form or online. Online applications must be received on or before Friday 8th June 2018. Entries made on the day of the event will be subject to a £2 price increase. Paper applications should be returned to your nominated school or posted to Northowram Burner, Northowram Primary School, Baxter Lane, Halifax, HX3 7EF. Race numbers for the participants of the 10km run will be handed out on the day at registration. To enter the Northowram Burner 10km run you must be 16 years of age or older on event day. Entrants aged 0 to 15 in the 2.5km run must be entered by a parent/guardian and must be accompanied by an adult who must also be entered. Each participant must agree to the disclaimer at the end of this document and these terms and conditions before participating in the event. All participants must be capable of completing the full distance, start line to finish line. By taking part, all participants confirm that they are happy for their names and any footage or photographs taken during their participation to be used to publicise any Northowram Primary School event. Participant race numbers cannot be exchanged with or sold to any other person. All entry fees are non-refundable and cannot be deferred towards a future event. Entries are non-transferable. Registration closure is determined and announced when event participation reaches the established capacity or a pre-set date which we reserve the right to change.

EVENT DAY

Participants must follow instructions as given from all event officials including race staff, volunteers and medical personnel throughout the duration of the event. All participants are expected to conduct themselves in a professional and courteous manner during the event. Every participant shall be provided with an event race number, which shall be conspicuously worn during the event. The event race number is to be worn as issued. No participant shall be permitted to participate in the event without the appropriate race number. All participants must write their name and details of any health problems or medication on the reverse of the race number, which must be worn on their shirt during the run. Dogs are not permitted on the course or within the event's ground before or after the race. Pushchairs and wheelchairs, where the course route safely allows, are permitted on the course and on the event's grounds.

THE COURSE

Participants shall assemble at the start no later than 10 minutes prior to the run starting. Participants shall then proceed to the start line as instructed. All participants must be positioned behind the starting line when starting. Any participant who refuses to obey the directions of the event officials, or who conducts himself/herself in an unsportsmanlike manner, or who is offensive by action or language to officials, volunteers, participants or spectators may be disqualified from the event and any future events. Any participant who has been found by an event official to have gained an unfair advantage by intentionally shortening the route of the run ("cutting the course") shall be immediately disqualified from the event. Any person who participates in the event without an official race number is subject to removal and disqualification, unless supervising a minor under the age of 16. A person will be allowed to accompany a participant if the participant is not physically/mentally able to complete the course alone.

PARTICIPANT SAFETY

Authorised medical personnel may examine any participant who appears in distress. If in the opinion of authorised medical personnel it is in the best interest of the participant's health and welfare, they can remove the participant from the event. Participants must retire at once from the run if ordered to do so by a member of the event's official staff. Event officials reserve the right to delay, cancel, alter the route or suspend the event due to extreme weather. No refund will be issued in these circumstances. As the race is run under UK Athletics rules and is on open roads, the wearing of headphones is strictly forbidden. Anyone seen wearing headphones will be withdrawn from the race and disqualified.

DISCLAIMER

In order to run in the Northowram Burner, runners must agree to the following disclaimer: "In completing this entry I declare that I, or anyone that I am paying for, will not compete in the run unless medically fit to do so and that, in any event, we will compete at my/our own risk. I accept that the organisers will not be liable for any loss, damage, action, claim, costs or expenses which may arise in consequence of my/our participation in the event. I/We understand that entry fees are non-refundable. I also hereby give my permission to use my/our name, quotes, video footage, and photographic likeness for marketing and promotional purposes. I agree to the full Terms and Conditions as displayed on the event website."
